Call for proposals – Small Research Projects #2, 2010

Wireless@KTH, the center for Wireless Systems at KTH aims at being the meeting place for trendsetting research in the area of Wireless systems interpreted in its wider sense. The center conducts projects that span from Mobile Applications and related Interface design on one end to wireless technology and infrastructure issues at the other end. Business related aspects of Wireless Systems are also an integral part of the research program. Details regarding the research program can be found in the center strategy document

You are invited to submit proposals for research projects within the scope of the research program of Wireless@KTH. The focus of the call is “seed projects” that could lead to larger Wireless@KTH-projects in cooperation with the industry partners of the center and projects exploring the feasibility of opening new, interesting research areas still not covered by the center. Proposals will be judged on the basis of the

- level of innovation,
- match with the objectives of research program,
- potential to spawn new Wireless@KTH projects (incl EU projects),
- scientific excellence of the proposal and the proposers.

In the first call in 2010 approximately 1,5 MSEK funding of projects & guest researchers was decided, The remaining budget is for 2010 is 1,5 MSEK for both small projects and guest researchers. The Wireless@KTH contribution does not exceed 500 KSEK for each project. Projects proposed, but not funded in previous rounds, are not automatically considered, but can be resubmitted. In these cases, the applicants should carefully note what changes they have introduced and how they have responded to the program councils review comments.

The applications should be short and **not exceeding 3-4 A4 pages** outlining the project scope, objectives and how they relate to the research program. Further, the research approach, staffing and intended financing should be addressed. Also plans beyond the current proposed project and the potential to create new activities in collaboration with Wireless@KTH industry partners and contacts with these partners should be stated briefly. Proposers should make sure that their application addresses the issues listed in the “[Checklist for proposers](#)” (updated 2008-11-07) which will form the basis of the evaluation.

Submissions should be prepared in MS Word or pdf-formats and should be received by the
